Topics include an overview of business structures, community analysis, feasibility, licensing and zoning, insurance, financing, recordkeeping, and taxes.

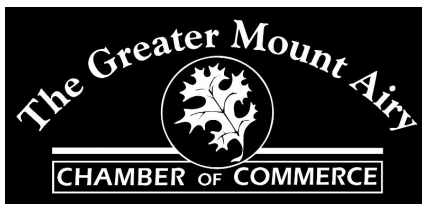
