

Everyone is being invited to participate in an upcoming Poverty Simulation.

The Poverty Simulation Workshop is a role-playing experience that offers an opportunity to learn more about the realities of living in conditions of poverty. It is a simulation, not a game. Participants enter the workshop with a new identity and family profile. The task of the family is to provide for basic necessities and shelter during the course of four weeks. Each week is compressed into a 15 minute simulation. Afterwards in the debriefing, they share insights learned during the simulation.

As a result, ordinary people from all walks of life can share a very special kind of awakening. The Poverty Simulation Workshop can open people's eyes to the human cost of poverty. The power of this unique learning resource is that it creates, like no other method, an insight into the state of chronic crisis that consumes so many working poor.
